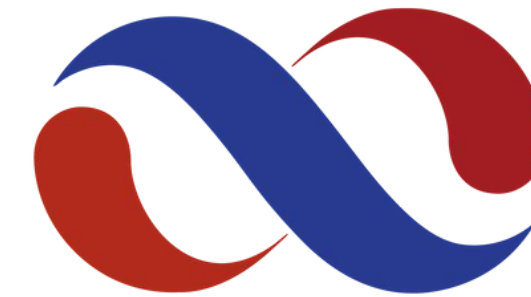

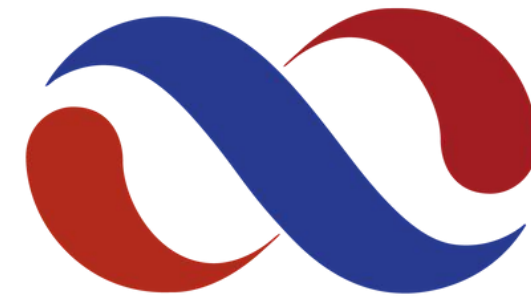
A high paced, short-duration environment, turnarounds demand experienced professionals and trades to complete an optimized scope safely and quickly.

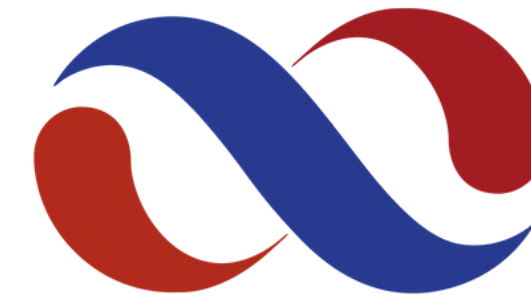
Heat Exchangers

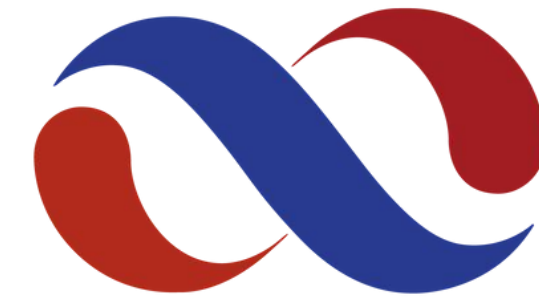

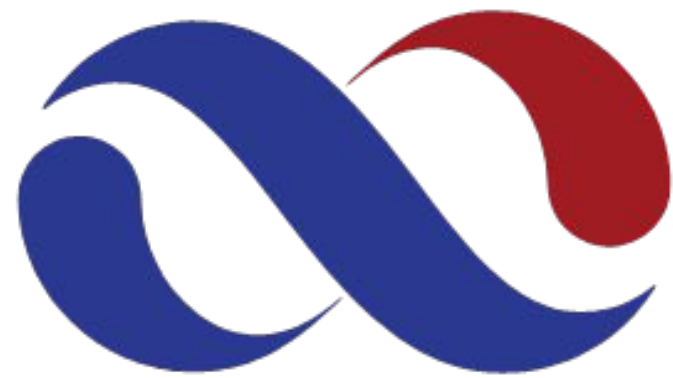
